To Parents

I regret that owing to the expenses having risen so sharply since the present fee was fixed, it has become necessary to increase the fees. Those for boys in form 1 will be £14.14.0 per term and the remainder of the boys £16.16.0. The increase will begin with the Summer term 1956.

It is hoped that, shortly, a large hall will be erected at the rear of the school. In this we shall have morning assembly, Physical Training, and Films. I also hope to engage a trained P.T. Instructor so that the boys can do apparatus work.

While I am writing, may I again ask that all clothing (including shoes)Be clearly marked with the boy's name. We shall then be able to return lost property.

Starting in January we are going to devote the last period in the afternoon to "prep". This will mean that there will be no work for boys to do at home. Boys will be under a master's supervision and we shall know that it is the boy's unaided work.
